Lebanon Humanitarian Needs Appeal

The Lebanese Red Cross operates ambulance and other emergency services in Lebanon.

The humanitarian situation in Lebanon is rapidly deteriorating. Since mid-September 2024, Lebanon has faced widespread attacks across many regions of the country as the armed conflict in the Middle East expands.

The conflict is making an already dire situation worse. Lebanon is already grappling with a long-standing socio-economic crisis. Nearly three-quarters of the population live below the poverty line. Now, faced with increased hostilities and damage to homes, hospitals, schools and infrastructure, over one million people have been displaced.

The Lebanese Red Cross, the Canadian Red Cross' local partner, is the most widely accepted humanitarian organization across Lebanon. They provide vital aid to people every day. In 2023, they provided free pre-hospital emergency care to 155,000 patients. The Red Cross is already working to deliver emergency relief and to get help to those impacted in Lebanon as quickly as possible and you can help.
