Funding can support new or existing activities that are critical to recovery-focused work including:

Community recovery through community strengthening initiatives or events, such as

- ✓ Mental health supports and services.
- ✓ Provision of direct services to those impacted by the wildfires.
- ✓ Restoring outdoor community or cultural spaces.
- ✓ Gatherings or events to support community connectedness.

Organizational recovery by building or rebuilding the organization's capacity, such as

- ✓ Specialized recovery training for staff and volunteers
- ✓ Reestablishing lost service capacity
- ✓ Volunteer engagement initiatives
- ✓ Initiatives to support new or increased needs, such as adapting existing services and/or hiring additional staff.

Who can apply

Registered charities and nonprofit organizations, municipal and regional entities, Indigenous governing bodies, and schools or school boards in 2025 Newfoundland & Labrador fire-impacted communities.



Available funding

Up to **\$25,000** for gatherings or events.
Up to **\$100,000** for longer-term recovery projects



Timelines

Proposals will be accepted on a rolling basis until **November 30, 2026**.

For short- and long-term activities between **October 1, 2025**, to **December 31, 2027**.
