



Residential Mitigation Incentive Program Photo Submission Checklist

Before-and-after photos are an important way to show the work you've completed—whether it's repairs, clean-up, or improvements. **Clear, high-quality photos** help demonstrate that the job meets program requirements and can be easily reviewed. To ensure your photos are accepted, they must be **taken during the day, in good lighting, and with proper focus** so they appear sharp and easy to see.

Please upload

- Only original, unedited photos in **JPG, JPEG, PNG, or GIF** format. If you're using an iPhone, be sure to convert **.HEIC** files to **.JPG** before uploading.
- Do not use screenshots, social media images, or apply filters, as these can reduce the quality and remove important information.
- Each photo file should be clearly named to indicate what it shows—for example: **Before_Driveway1.jpg** or **After_Siding2.jpg**. This makes it easier for us to understand and verify your submission.



Before photos (taken before any work begins)

- Take at least two wide-angle photos of the work area** from different angles.
 - This helps provide a full view of the space.
 - You can include more photos if needed to show the area clearly.
- Make sure each photo includes part of the house** (e.g., windows, siding, porch) to help identify exactly where the photo was taken.
- Include one photo that clearly shows the house number or address** (e.g., mailbox, front door) if it's not visible in your wide-angle shots.



After photos (taken after project completion)

- Take at least 2 wide-angle photos from the same positions as the “before” photos**
 - This allows for a direct comparison of the changes
 - You can include more photos if needed to show the area clearly.
- Include a recognizable part of the house** (e.g. same window, siding, or door as shown in the “before” photos) to confirm the location and perspective match.
- Tree Replacement Photo:** show the distance between the house and any newly planted trees to demonstrate they follow **FireSmart™ Guidelines**.
- OPTIONAL:** Include close-up shots of newly installed materials or improvements.

Please include clear photos of any purchased items, as well as receipts or invoices for any work performed.
