YOUTH LEADER PATHWAY

Below is the pathway to becoming a certified Canadian Red Cross Youth Leader. You must successfully complete each step before advancing to the next step. Certification is valid for 3 years.

1 CHECK PREREQUISITES



Step one consists of confirming prerequisites are met: you must be certified in Standard First Aid and CPR/AED Level C and be at least 18 years old or 16-17 years old with on-site adult support.

2 FUNDAMENTALS OF INSTRUCTION



Step two is an online component (5-7 hrs) where you will learn the fundamentals of instruction and be informed on the Teaching Experience process.

3 TEACHING EXPERIENCE



In step 3, you will complete a teaching experience in a real Youth First Aid classroom.*

4 CERTIFICATION



The final step is the certification. Congratulations! You are now officially a certified Youth Leader.

*Candidates with experience as an Educator or qualification(s) in recreation leadership may qualify for the Youth Leader Transfer pathway and may not be required to complete the Teaching Experience.
