WORKFORCE

4,475 Personnel actively engaged in operations

1,950+ Rapid Responders (available for emergency response)

8,400+ Volunteers (total volunteers across organization)



COVID-19 ENGAGEMENTS

Support to **18** Federal and **110+** Provincial COVID-19 engagements

- This includes **14** Federal Requests for Assistance (RFAs) supported by the Red Cross since 2020, such as: support for vaccination; long-term care and retirement homes; testing and tracing; health human resources including ICU nurses in hospitals; epidemic prevention and control support across sectors and in communities; and isolation centres.

Support to Indigenous Communities:

- **32** COVID-19 engagements primarily serving Indigenous communities, including: health human resources; vaccination; long-term care; epidemic prevention and control; emergency response in BC, AB, MB, ON, NWT, YK, QC; and a virtual help desk.



SUPPORT TO VACCINATION & TESTING

Support to vaccination efforts in **6** provinces (British Columbia, Alberta, Manitoba, Quebec, Ontario, Prince Edward Island)

- **660+** Vaccination Sites to Date
- **79,700+** Vaccinations administered

Support to supervised self-collection facilities at Canadian land border crossings:

- **21** sites supported
- **363,800+** individuals supported



OUTBREAK CRISIS MANAGEMENT

19 isolation sites supported (PHAC isolation sites, Ontario Migrant Workers)

14,300+ isolated individuals supported

375+ sites supported with epidemic prevention and control expertise. (This includes long-term care centres, rehabilitation centres, correctional facilities, Indigenous communities, and isolation sites)
